

2017 Eau Claire County Swine Project (3/29/2017)

The 2017 project will be a non-terminal show this year. As a result there will be additional Exhibitor Responsibilities to ensure a healthy and safe fair for all exhibitors.

Project animals will be weighed in by the exhibitor/family at the owner's own risk. It will be the exhibitor's responsibility to practice bio-security during and after the weigh-in and throughout the project. The Eau Claire County Livestock Project shall be held harmless for any loss or illness.

Should exhibitors elect to bring more than one hog, it is their responsibility to confirm where the extra hog will be going after the fair. **This MUST be confirmed in writing on or before July 1.** If the exhibitor chooses to take the hog to slaughter the name of the processing facility MUST be completed by the exhibitor on the form below along with the signed confirmation of the facility that is accepting the hog.

Extra hogs or breeding animals, which are brought home, shall be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to ensure that appropriate bio-safety/quarantine measures are provided for the health of the animals they bring home and the ones that remained home. Exhibitors weighing in animals and showing animals at the Eau Claire County Fair do so at their own risk and shall understand that the following groups including but not limited to: Eau Claire County Fair, Eau Claire County Livestock Project, Eau Claire County Fair Committee, Eau Claire County 4-H, FFA's, Eau Claire County Livestock Group, Eau Claire County Board, Friends of the Fair or any member of the fair staff, assume no responsibility for health issues of the swine project animals either during or after the weigh-in or for any illness or loss of animals while the project animal is at the fair or after it leaves the fair.


Exhibitors will be responsible to transport all extra hogs from the grounds to the accepting processing facility or back home after the fair. ALL animals must be off the grounds by 5PM, Sunday, July 30.
