

Club Award Guidelines

Club Evaluation Form – this process is discontinued. Clubs are encouraged to apply for awards for recognition using the guidelines below. The half-sheet of paper will no longer be required.

Club Activity Reports and Super Club Award applications are usually due the first Monday in October for the activities your club emphasized this year (health/safety, community service, Cloverbuds, conservation, and recreation). Clubs submitting Activity Reports to be considered for County Awards may use any format they choose. Clubs must use the self-nomination form below to nominate for these areas. **A club book or a report must be turned in for this award. Each club's report/book will be reviewed by the Banquet Committee, and winners in each category will be selected. A club may receive an award in more than one category. Certificates will be given for selections in all categories. Top winners in each category will be selected and will receive a certificate and a \$10 gift certificate for the club to use at 4-H Mall.**

Super Club Recognition is awarded to each club that submits a book/report in a special area, determined by the Banquet Committee. These awards receive a certificate of recognition, based on an area that the committee feels the club has really excelled in during the past 4-H year. The club may be recognized for a specific event they created, an event attended, etc. **Each club who turns in a book/report for the Club Activity Reports/Super Club Award will receive recognition in this division.**
